Hebrews 13:3

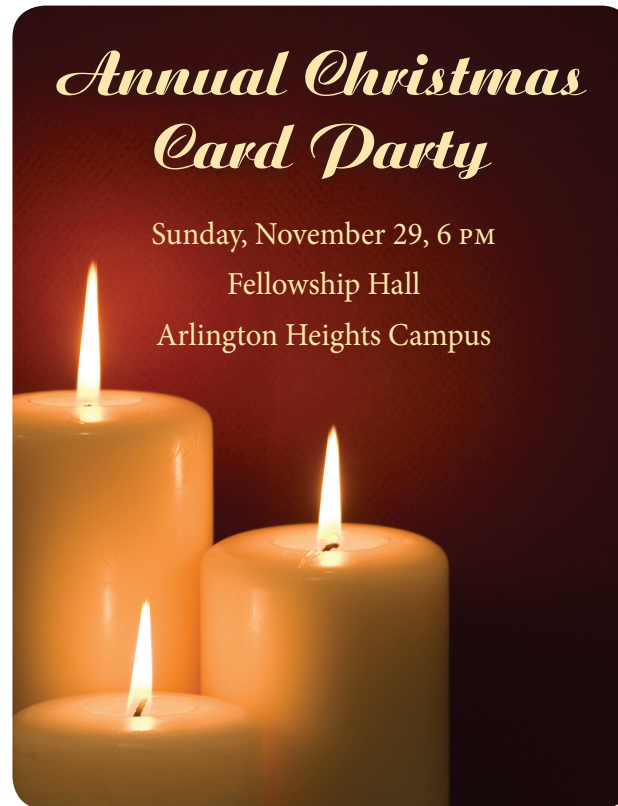
WHAT IS CHRISTIAN ADVOCACY?

Christian Advocacy is a unique ministry that responds to God's call to remember those in prison and those who are being mistreated. On the last Sunday of each month, concerned followers of Jesus come together to pray for those who are being oppressed around the world. The special focus is on those who are persecuted for their faith and their commitment to see the reach of the Gospel message extended in our time. Those who oppress them are also a focus of prayer and concern.

During our meetings, participants write letters of encouragement to people imprisoned for their faith. They also send letters of advocacy to political leaders on behalf of particular individuals and encourage government officials to address and uphold human rights within their countries' borders.
